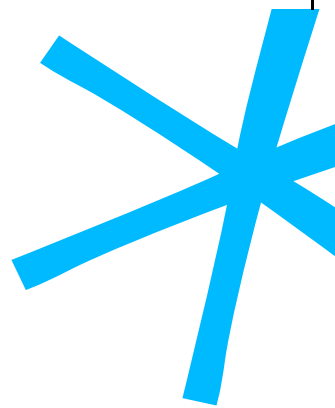


# DAY 27

### Do

Choose a picture from a magazine, a postcard or printed from the internet. It could be a picture of nature, a city scene, anything that inspires you or grabs your attention. Choose as many words as you can that describe what you see, or what the picture makes you feel, then write them down in a list to create a poem that describes that picture. You could write on top of the picture, or on a new sheet of paper. Give your poem a title!

### If you have more time...

Can you find a creative way to recreate your picture? Perhaps by creating the scene in a drawing or collage - or by dressing up and using the objects around you!

### Think

What does the picture make you think about? How does it make you feel? Do you know why you chose this picture?
