


DAY 6

Do

Make a Kenning Poem about you. A Kenning is a pair of words that describes something without calling it by its name. A Kenning poem uses a list of Kennings to describe something in an interesting way, like this one about snow:

Cloud confetti
Land icing
Field blanket
Solid rain

Make a Kenning poem about you. You might be a Picture drawer, Cake maker, Smile spreader, Hug giver, Goal scorer, Friend maker...

If you have more time...

Try writing a Kenning poem about something else. The sun, the ocean, a particular animal... can someone else guess what it's about?

If someone heard your poem, how would they guess it was about you?
